

HERON LAKES WOMEN'S 18-HOLE GOLF CLUB BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be Heron Lakes Women's 18-Hole Golf Club.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

The purpose of this club shall be to promote an interest in golf, to plan and conduct such golf and social activities as the members desire, establish and maintain standard handicaps for all active members and to **foster and perpetuate harmony, good will and sportsmanship** among all its members and guests.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

Any woman who is eligible for a golf membership in Leisure World, Mesa Arizona may apply for membership.

Social Member – Any member who has been an annual fee-paying member in the past may be a social member (no golf). Membership is \$10.

ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS

Sec. 1. Officer of the Club shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. See job descriptions for their duties.

Sec. 2. A nominating committee composed of the immediate past president and one or more persons selected by the Executive Board shall propose a slate of officers to be presented to the general membership at the February meeting with election of officers and install of these officers taking place in March.

Sec. 3. Officers shall serve one (1) year or until their successors shall have been duly appointed or elected. Any vacancy in any office shall be filled by the President for the unexpired portion of that term or until she is able to appoint a member to fill the vacancy. In case there is but one nominee for an office by motion from the floor, the Secretary shall be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot. Maximum term for the President, Vice-President and Secretary positions shall be two (2) consecutive years. Maximum term for the Treasurer position shall be three (3) years.

Sec. 4. The President and Treasurer must create an annual budget as early as possible following the March elections.

Sec. 5. An Executive Board shall be composed of the elected Officers, the Tournament Chairperson, the Handicap Chairperson, and the immediate Past President and any other position as may be deemed necessary. The Website Chairperson and the Communications Chairperson are none-voting members of the Executive Board. The Executive Board shall be empowered to conduct such necessary business as may arise in the interim, subject to notification to the membership at the next regular meeting.

ARTICLE V – MEETINGS

Sec. 1. Regular business meetings shall be held monthly as necessary from November through April.

Sec. 2. The President shall preside at all general membership meetings of the Club. In her absence the VP shall preside.

ARTICLE VI – DUES

Annual dues shall be determined by the Board.
