

GOLFER'S ETIQUETTE OF PLAY

- **Be Alert**...don't hamper a player by standing too close or parking your cart/bag too close; don't walk across or stand in their line on the putting surface.
- **Be Courteous**...don't slow play; allow faster players to play through and do your practicing on the practice range.
- **Be Honest**...count all your strokes; turn in all your scores.
- **Be Informed**...read the Heron Lakes local and USGA rulebook and always keep it with you. Familiarize yourself with the rules.
- **Be Kind**...help a player in trouble but let the Pro give the lessons.
- **Be Prepared**...have your club selected and be at your ball and ready to play when it's your turn.
- **Be Wise**...if you're not following the procedures, you're not playing golf.

MEMBER CHECKLIST

Attire	Wear appropriate women's golf attire for League Play. Per Leisure World policy, shirts may be sleeveless and collarless. Any color and/or style of denim is not allowed. Golf shoes must have soft spikes. Shoes/Boots with large tread (anything that may damage the course) are not permitted.
Cancellation Policy	Be sure to call the Pro Shop if you are signed up and are unable to play. By doing this, you provide the Pro Shop with time to reassign the foursomes.
Events	There are 8 golf events during the season: Welcome Back Brunch (November), Christmas Party (December), Invitational(or another special event), Valentines Party (February), Combined Championship Celebration (February), Member-Guest, Eclectic Tournament (March) and Fun Day (April). Costs, which include golf and catered food, vary from event to event. Three events are no charge to league members (Welcome Back Brunch, Combined Championship Celebration and Fun Day).
Flights	League members are placed in flights based on the member's handicap and assigned by the golf pro on each league day.
General Meetings	General Meetings are conducted once a month in the afternoon after golf. The schedule is posted on the 9 Hole Bulletin Board as the dates vary from season to season. Members are highly encouraged to attend the General Meetings which usually last less than an hour. This will keep you informed of events and information about the League.
Golf Cart	During tournament play, members are required to ride in a golf cart. If you do not have a golf cart, your partner will most likely have one. If not, talk to the Golf Pro to let him know that you do not have a cart.

Membership	<p>Membership dues which include the AGA handicap fees should be paid no later than December 31st. AGA and league membership are paid on-line at www.azgolf.org</p> <p>The member roster is emailed to all members and updated as needed. The roster is confidential and should not be distributed to non-league members.</p> <p>Any monies paid to the league for dues or reimbursement for expenses must be paid online or by cash or US check and placed in an envelope in the box marked Ladies 9 Hole in the credenza under the computer in the Heron Lakes golf lounge. Do Not Make Any League Payments to The Pro Shop. There is a box marked Ladies 9 Hole for all payments.</p>
Name Badge	<p>League members are required to wear their name badges when playing on League Day. (If you are waiting for Leisure World name tags, please place a piece of tape with your name on a visible part of your clothing.)</p>
Non-League Scores	<p>Scores for every non-league play should be posted in the Handicap System to ensure an accurate handicap and flight placement. Scores should be posted in the computer in the Heron Lakes lounge at GHIN.com or azgolf.org. If you are unsure how to do this, ask the Pro to assist you.</p>
Play	<p>We play either the Front 9 or the Back 9 on Tuesdays as indicated on the golf schedule posted on the Women's 9 Hole Bulletin Board.</p>
Postings	<p>Explanation of Handicap, and Games are on the 9 Hole Bulletin Board. Check the board frequently to ensure you are informed of events.</p>
Raffle	<p>Prior to each League Day play, there is a 50/50 raffle which you can participate for \$1.00 per tickets.</p>
Refreshments	<p>Refreshments are served each week after golf. These refreshments are provided with the 50/50 funds.</p>
Rules	<p>Rules of golf are observed on all League Days. League members should be familiar with the local and course rules on the rules' cards distributed to all members. These cards can answer most questions that arise during play. The Rules chair and/or the Pro Shop are available for further clarification.</p> <p>Reference: USGA Player's Edition of the Rules of Golf 2019</p>

Scores	Members winning scores by flight and payouts on League Day are posted on the bulletin board. All winnings are in sweeps redeemable at either Leisure World Pro Shop. All league play scores are recorded in the Handicap System by the Pro.
Scoring	When you finish a hole, move to the next hole before recording your score to allow the following foursome to tee off.
Sign in	Please arrive about 20 minutes prior to the League Day tee time. You must report in to the Pro Shop no later than 20 minutes prior to tee time or your spot may be reassigned.
Signup	The deadline for signup for the following week is before 10 am Monday. The signup sheet is found on the golf signup bulletin board on the west wall of the Pro Shop Lounge. For special events, signup sheets will be on the Ladies 9 Hole Bulletin Board. Late signups may not be always accommodated.
Tournaments	The major tournaments are: Christmas Party with the 18-hole ladies league, Invitational, Combined Championship (2 weeks), Valentines Party with the 18-hole ladies league, Member-Member/Member-Guest, Eclectic and Fun Day. It is highly encouraged that you participate in as many of these tournaments as possible.
Website	All documents, except member information, are posted on the league website - golf.lwca.com - under Leagues - HLLGL (9 Hole).
