

1. **Free relief** from all of the following:
 - a. maintained planting beds, canals, cart paths, staked trees, control boxes, sprinkler heads, restrooms, drainage and culvert areas (rocks between #10 green and the lake, rocks on #17 between path and wall).
 - b. Canal on #10 to be played as free relief and dropped on the course side of #10.
 - c. Canal on #17 to be played as free relief and dropped on the course side of #17
 - d. Find your nearest point of relief no **nearer to the hole** and drop within one club length of that spot. This relief is not for line of flight.

2. **Out-of-bounds** is determined by white stakes, fences and walls where there are no stakes. If your ball comes to rest against a wall or fence marking out of bounds, you can take an unplayable for a one stroke penalty (Rule 19). **No free relief from objects defining out of bounds.**
 - a. The area to the right of the cart path on holes #10, 11 (tee), 13, 14 and 15 **where white stakes are not present** is considered out of bounds.
 - i. 1 stroke plus distance going back to where you hit your previous shot (as near as possible) or
 - ii. 2 strokes allows the player to drop in a large area between the point where the ball has gone out of bounds and the edge of the fairway of the hole being played that is not nearer the hole (Rule E-5)

3. **Penalty Areas**
 - a. The **lake to the right of #13** is no longer OB and is considered a penalty area
 - b. Taking relief from a penalty area is one stroke.
 - i. you may take relief by dropping on the spot at which your last stroke was made under stroke and distance
 - ii. back-on-the-line relief
 - iii. drop a ball into a relief area measured from where your ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area. From that reference point, you are allowed to drop outside the penalty area within two club-lengths from that spot, no nearer to the hole (Rule 17).
 - iv. drop area to the left of #5

Additional information

- Carts must stay a minimum of 20 yards from tees and greens
- Please repair all ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.
